## Letter to Parents or Carers of All Children

Dear Parent or Carer

From Monday 31<sup>st</sup> March, DEFRA are bringing in a new legislation that businesses have to dispose of all food waste separately to any other waste.

This will have an effect on the whole school as FSU & KS1 have fruit, we provide breakfast & tea at Breakfast & Afterschool club and lunchtimes for the whole school, including staff.

School will now have to dispose of food waste separate to food packaging.

This means that from 31<sup>st</sup> March any child who has a packed lunch will have to take home anything left over from their lunch. To try to minimise the amount of waste being sent home in lunchboxes, please could you try to use as little packaging as possible in packed lunches.

Mr Blakeley will be talking to the children about the changes in assembly on Monday, with them starting to practice putting food waste in the bins provided for food waste only on Wednesday with the aim that they know what they have to do by Monday 31<sup>st</sup> March.
