Dear Parent or Guardian

We are writing to inform you that your child will be weighed and measured by the Locala 0-19 Team at school in the next few weeks as part of the National Child Measurement Programme.

### **Height and weight checks for children in Year 6**

Every year in England, school children in reception and year 6 have their height and weight checked at school. This is called the National Child Measurement Programme (NCMP). The checks are carried out by registered school nurses or trained health and care providers. Children are measured fully clothed, except for their coats and shoes, in a private space away from other pupils.

### **Why do we need to measure children?**

Children's height and weight measurements are collected to build an understanding of how children are growing. The information from the NCMP is used by local councils and the NHS to plan the provision of health and leisure services for families to promote healthier growth in children.

In most areas, parents receive their child's measurement data, because this can be useful information about their child's growth. Your child's class will take part in this year's programme.

### **What information is collected and why**

Your child's height, weight, age, sex, and date of birth are collected to calculate their weight category (also known as child body mass index).

Your child's ethnicity and address are collected to monitor differences in child growth and weight between ethnic groups, where children live and their backgrounds.

Your child's name, date of birth and NHS number are collected to link their measurements from reception and year 6 to other information from health and education records held by

NHS England, the Department of Health and Social Care and the Department for Education, where it is legal to do so.

### Information about how personal information and data is collected and stored

We will store your child's information as part of their local child health record on the NHS's child health information database and share it with their GP.

All the information collected about your child will be sent by us to NHS England. NHS England is responsible for collecting data and information about health and care so that this can be used to monitor and improve the care provided to people across England.

### How you can withdraw your child from participating in the NCMP

**If you are happy for your child to be measured, the check will go ahead in school and you do not need to do anything.**

If you do not want your child's height and weight to be measured, or your child has a medical condition that affects their height or weight **please inform your child's school in writing within 7 days of receiving this letter.**

***Children will not be made to participate if they do not want to.***

Parents/carers will receive an SMS text message containing a webpage link to your child's weight category.

Please contact the Locala 0-19 service on 030 0304 5555 if you do not receive your child's result within 8 weeks of being measured.

### **How is a child's wellbeing considered in the NCMP**

The wellbeing of children and families is very important. Measurements are conducted in a sensitive way, in private and away from other children. Individual feedback is not shared with your child or their school.

The weight and height information is shared only with you via SMS and web link. It is your choice to share or not share the information with your child. There are some useful resources to help you make these decisions here: <https://www.nhs.uk/healthier-families/childrens-weight>
