**Staffing:**

**PE uniform:**

Following half term, your child can come to school dressed in their PE kit when they are taking part in a PE session. This will help maximize their curriculum time. Indoor PE uniform is a white T shirt (this can be plain or with the school logo) with navy blue or black shorts. Outdoor PE uniform is plain black, navy blue or grey jogging bottoms with a plain navy blue or black sweat shirt with or without a zip (no visible sport brand markings). There may be occasions when your child's class teacher may ask for pumps or a change of footwear depending on their PE activity. Please ensure all clothing items have your child's name written on them.

**Wrap around care:**

After the half term holidays, both Breakfast Club and After School Club will be located in our hall. Therefore, parents and carers picking up their child will walk a little further to the adjacent hall door at the back of the building. There may be occasions when the children are playing outside at which point the back gate will be closed and pick up will take place from the back gate.
