### Monday Literacy Lesson 1

Read the power point story Knights and Dragons Unite!

Have a go at the grammar challenge cards.

Remember:- Common nouns are names of places, people and things.

Eg. school, cook, table

Proper nouns are the names of places, people and things with capital letters.

( Days of week, months of year, countries, towns, names of people)

Eg. England, Jack, Monday

Adjectives are describing words. They describe nouns.

modern school      clever cook      wooden table

Punctuation you can use:-

. , ! ? `

### Tuesday Literacy Lesson 2

Write a description of the dragon.

Remember you can write what he looks like and also how he acts.

You can use adjectives or similes to make your sentences more interesting.

Eg. The dragon has **pointy** horns **as sharp as a pin**.

You can put conjunctions in your sentences to make them longer.

Eg. The dragon has wings **which** can help the dragon fly as fast as a rocket!

**Don't forget to think in sentences and remember your capital letters!**
