

Monday

- Warm up:- counting in tens across the hundreds
- Counting in tens to work out the totals.
Write the calculation before you work out the totals.

Tuesday

- Warm up:- Finding change

Do you count back or find the difference?

It's often quicker to find the difference with numbers that aren't that far apart when you count in tens or 1's.

Remember, you can draw your own number line to work out change when the numbers are far apart.

- Find change in pence or find change in pounds.

You must write the symbol. There is a big difference between £3 and 3p.

Remember, you don't have the right money in your purse so you give the shopkeeper too much. He takes the money he needs for the bought thing, and what's left is your change.

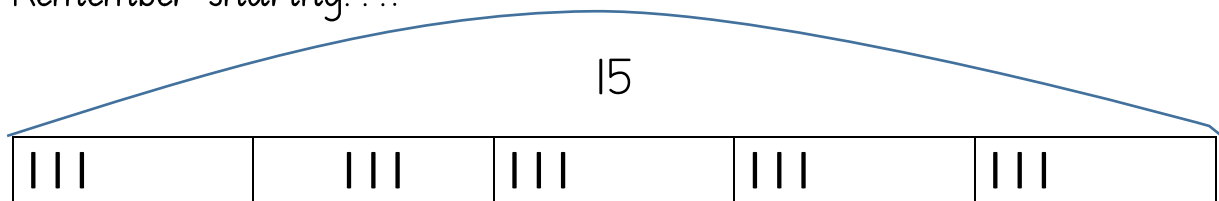
Write the calculation before you work it out.

A whole split into two equal pieces:- halves

A whole split into three equal pieces:- thirds

A whole split into four equal pieces:- quarters
