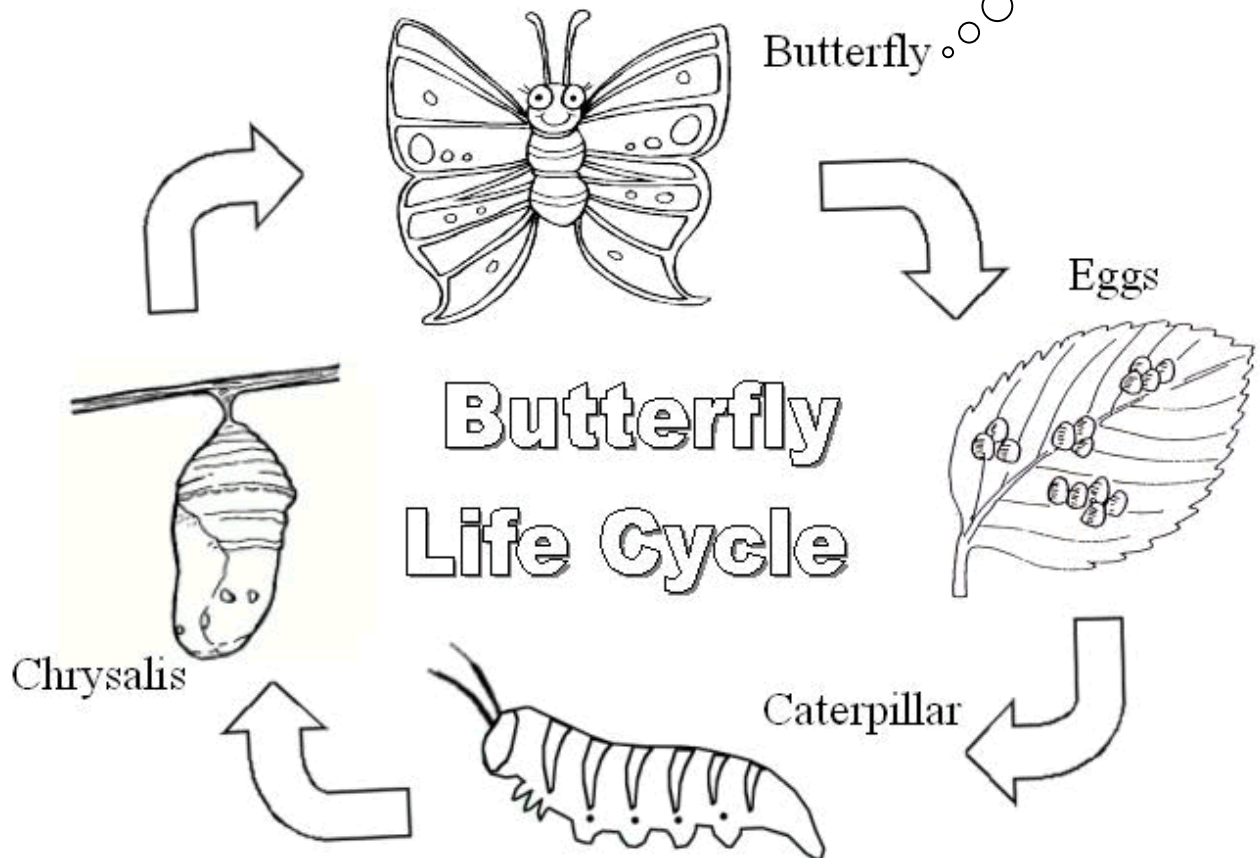

Butterfly Life Cycle

Monarch butterflies begin their life as an egg. The eggs are laid on milkweed leaves. The eggs hatch into baby caterpillars with black, yellow and white stripes. The caterpillars only eat milkweed leaves.

The baby caterpillars eat the milkweed leaves for a couple of weeks. Then the caterpillar forms a green chrysalis. The chrysalis is shiny with gold specks. This is called the pupal stage.

After about fourteen days, the adult butterfly will emerge from the chrysalis. The butterfly waits until its wings dry and it feels strong. Then it flies away to start the life cycle all over again.

When the weather gets colder, the monarch butterfly flies to a warmer country. This is called migration. It stays in that warm country from November- February. When it gets to the warm country, it finds a tree and hibernates for the whole of the winter. Then it returns back to its home in Spring.
