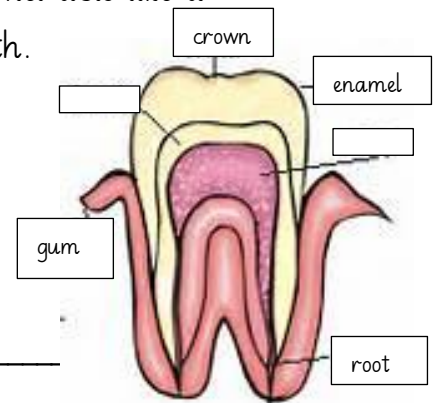


### Show off your teeth

Smile and show off your teeth. Teeth are like bones. They are alive. Teeth start to grow before you are born.

Children have about twenty teeth before they turn three years old. Your first teeth are called baby teeth. When you turn five or six you will start to grow adult teeth. Your baby teeth will fall out.

The part of the tooth that you can see is called the crown. The crown of each tooth has enamel on it. Enamel is hard and shiny. The enamel acts like a bodyguard for your teeth. It protects the insides of your teeth.
