

## El home learning- Zoo animals - Elmer

### Communication, Language and literacy

Discussing elephants, where they live, what they eat.

You can view zoos through live streaming on YouTube and watch elephant feeds.

Talk about why you are special and why others are special to you- what makes you special and why?

### Reading

Elmer stories – Use YouTube if you prefer or do not have any Elmer stories at home.

Elephants – Use Espresso to look at elephants and their habitats.

### Numeracy

Colour by number activity- Twinkl

Singing number rhymes

Using small world animals can you match the correct amount of animals to each number.

### Outdoor play

Drawing elephants using chalk or water and paint brush- can you create a colourful elephant like Elmer?

Walking like an elephant in the garden or playing follow the leader and following others around, copying what they do.

### Art and design

Painting story stones to create your own stories for family members.

Colour mixing to see primary colours change to secondary and tertiary colours. Use the colours to paint a lovely picture.

### Pencil control

Drawing a jungle with elephants and leaves etc.

Writing your name and writing numbers

### Water play-

Create a wash station for the elephants- provide small world elephants and soapy water to clean each animal.

### Role play

Create different animal role play masks.

### Baking

Baking elephant shaped biscuits and decorating them.
