### Making Easter cards

There are templates on the website 'Twinkl' of eggs with various patterns that can be used for the front of the card.

You may also like to try using ripped paper to create a sheep or a rabbit for the front. You could even use your hand print to make a chick!

There are also other ideas on the internet that you can use.

### Painting eggs

You could have a challenge with your siblings/friends to design a pattern or create a character on a hard boiled egg. I wonder what wonderful egg creations you will make, why don't you show us by posting on Tapestry!

### Easter hats

Why not try making an Easter cone hat. All you need is some paper, string and pens.

Curl the paper around to make a cone shape and stick the edges together using tape. You could make it really colourful using a variety of pens and crayons or you could turn it into a bunny or a chick by adding either extra paper for ears or for a chick- feathers.

### Easter wreath

Cut about 12 egg shapes out of paper, decorate them using pens, pencils and craft accessories before arranging them into a circle and gluing together. You could hang it on your front door for others to see.

### Little chicks

If you have empty egg boxes you could cut the bottoms off and paint them before placing one on top of the other and adding eyes and a feather for the tail.

### Toilet roll rabbits

Can you create a bunny using a toilet tube? Can you cut out ears and a tail and stick it onto the bunny? What colour bunny are you going to create? Mine was a rainbow bunny ☺.
