Acceptable User Policy Agreement for Children Using Technology in School

- I know what to do and who to talk to if I feel worried, uncomfortable, vulnerable or at risk whilst using technology, or if I know of someone to whom this is happening

- I will report all online safety incidents to my teacher or an appropriate members of staff
- I will discuss online safety issues with family and friends in an open and honest way
- I will not intentionally damage any school technology or try to change interfaces such as homepage screens
- I will not share any username or password with anyone and will not try to use anyone else's.
- I will not intentionally search on the internet for inappropriate content; including, for example, rude words and actions, violence, drugs.

- I understand that the school has a monitoring and filtering system where inappropriate content and searches are filtered. As part of this system Mr Blakeley and Miss Henderson are notified about any inappropriate content that is searched for.
