Supply	£370.07	Staff members have been able to attend competitions and/or training with the children.
PSP Membership	£3000	Both children and staff are supported by the staff at PSP who engage in activities, sporting events, competitions and training.
PSP sports coaches	£1525	Sports coaches work with the children during after school clubs to develop both the children and staffs PE abilities. Teachers work alongside the coaches to learn and develop their own skills.
Trim trail and playground extension	£4642	Children now access a new play area designed by them and created by PlayForce.
Equipment for school including helmets and scooters	£1562	Range of equipment that will benefit all children across school- this includes helmets, scooters, storage, football nets, play leader equipment and running vests.
Defibrillator	£1029	The school bought a defibrillator for emergency use and received training on how to use it.
Sports barn transport	£220	Children in Year 4 had to opportunity during school sports week to go to the sports barn on Leeds Road and take part in activities with other children from the Kirklees area.
