NQT Introduction to teaching PE	£150.00	From September 2016 we had two new teachers join our school that were NQTs, this course was available so therefore I asked them if they would like to go on. Both NQT's attended the course and found it very valuable as well as giving them the confidence to carry out a range of different PE sessions with their class.

Y2	Part of Peripatetic PE Service £2,730.00	Staff are much more confident in teaching gymnastics, have many more ideas and know how to make sure the children are progressing and are being challenged. Pupil progress during these lessons was rapid, children encountered more challenging activities and the basics of core strengths and flexibility were really developed.
Specialist Teachers in ball skills and movement Y1	Part of Peripatetic PE Service £2,730.00	Within Year 1 the teachers are now more confident at teaching ball skills. We had one new teacher in this year group and it has helped her to see how PSP work and the skills they can offer. The children all progressed well and used some of the movement skills they had used within these sessions to think of and perform a gymnastics routine at Cym Mirfield.
