Dear Parents or Carers

Shopping Walks

As part of our provision for your child's development in the area of learning – Understanding the world; People and communities, we are planning to take the children shopping in the local community. This will involve the children walking from school to local shops to buy groceries for our cooking / baking tasks. This will include walking as far as the Co-operative and Lidl Supermarkets.

The children will be on a rota, making the trip in small groups of up to eight children. They will be accompanied by staff and volunteers from the foundation 2 team. The trips are scheduled throughout the term.

Staff will carry a school mobile phone and a small first aid kit. They will be briefed on the safety requirements for the trip. The children will be given clear expectations of their required behaviour.

In order for us to bake and buy the ingredients whilst shopping we ask that if you are able to please make a contribution towards our baking fund; this would be greatly appreciated. This money can be given to Mrs Bates on the school gate or to the adult on the Foundation 2 door.

Risk assessments have been completed for the walks and are available on request. A list of the children that will make the trip on any given week will be displayed in the classroom for your information.

Please could you complete the form on ParentPay to give consent for your child to go on the walks; children will not be taken out of school without parent/carer consent. Completing the form will provide consent for the whole year for your child to make a trip to local shops only.
